Step-by-step instructions:

- A. Engage someone in conversation. A great way to do this is by asking a question to generate a response/discussion. When talking with someone ask them question 1.
- B. Below are common responses people give to questions 1.

 Role-play with the group. Have one person be an "evangelist" and one person be a "non-Christian."
- C Have the "evangelist" ask the first question. Have the "non-Christian" give one of the common responses below. (Try to role-play each response per class with evangelist/non-Christian). The "evangelist" is given a set of responses to help with an apt reply to keep the conversation positive/going.
- D. Below you will see other questions the "evangelist" asks to move toward a Bible study. This includes the "salvation story." Try to get the details as you talk with them. Once they share their salvation story, ask them if you can share yours. Have two Bibles and use them to share how you came to Christ.
